Terms & Conditions

1. The Railcard is not valid unless it has been signed by the holder.
2. The Railcard is not transferable, the holder must travel as part of the party on all occasions when the Railcard is being used.
3. The Railcard must be presented when buying discounted tickets in conjunction with it.
4. The Railcard must be carried on all journeys when discounted tickets bought in conjunction with it are being used.
5. When requested by rail staff, the holder must show the valid Railcard, otherwise the full fare will be payable.
6. If the Railcard becomes defaced, illegible or torn it will not be valid (a replacement card will be issued upon payment of an administration fee).
7. The Train Companies may refuse to issue or renew a Railcard and do not undertake to replace lost or stolen Railcards.
8. Discounted tickets are acceptable for travel on services operated by the following Train Companies: First Great Western, South West Trains and Virgin Trains, or their successors.
9. Discounted tickets are issued subject to the National Conditions of Carriage and those conditions listed in this leaflet and in the event of conflict the conditions listed in this leaflet shall apply.
10. Discounted tickets may only be used within the validity of the Railcard held and cease to be valid on expiry of the Railcard, unless presented with a renewal Railcard.
11. Where facilities exist tickets must be bought before boarding the train, and if this is not done Railcard holders will be required to pay the full Standard Single or Return fare without the benefit of any discount. Where ticket issuing facilities are not available at a station, tickets may be purchased on the train at the appropriate discounted fare.

Save one-third on train fares in Devon and Cornwall



Devon & Cornwall Railcard

The new Devon & Cornwall Railcard offers residents of Devon and Cornwall one-third off most Standard Class off-peak train tickets across Devon and Cornwall, including PlusBus tickets, for just £10 a year. Discounted tickets can be used for travel on First Great Western, South West Trains and Virgin Trains services. One accompanying adult also receives one-third off their ticket and you can take up to four accompanying children (aged 5-15) for a flat fare of £1 each (£2 for Day Ranger tickets).

Am I eligible?

Anyone aged 16 years of age or over, who is resident within the counties of Devon or Cornwall, City of Plymouth or Isles of Scilly can apply for a Devon & Cornwall Railcard.

Which tickets do I receive discounts on?

- 1/3 off Cheap Day Return / Single for journeys wholly within Devon and Cornwall, including PlusBus tickets

- 1/3 off Saver Return / Single for journeys wholly within Devon and Cornwall, including PlusBus tickets
- 1/3 off Devon Day Ranger
- 1/3 off Cornwall Day Ranger
- 1/3 off individual branch line Day Rangers for:
 - Tarka Line (Exeter Central – Barnstaple)

- Atlantic Coast Line (Par to Newquay)
- Looe Valley Line (Liskeard to Looe)
- Tamar Valley Line (Plymouth to Gunnislake)
- Maritime Line (Truro to Falmouth Docks)
- 1/2 off St Ives Bay Line Day Ranger

How much does the card cost?

£10 for one year.

How do I get a Devon & Cornwall Railcard?

To get a Devon & Cornwall Railcard please complete the application form in this leaflet and take it, together with proof of residency and proof of identity, to any staffed station within Devon and Cornwall or any National Rail travel agent within Devon and Cornwall.

What documents are accepted as proof of residency and proof of identity?

Proof of residency:

- Council tax bill
- Utility bill
- Bank/credit card statement
- Driving licence

Proof of identity:

- Passport
- Driving Licence (incorporating a photo)
- College / Work ID

What tickets do I not get a discount off?

- Tickets that extend outside Devon and Cornwall
- Season tickets
- Standard Day or Standard Open tickets
- First Class tickets, although you can upgrade a discounted Standard ticket at weekends by paying the normal weekend upgrade charge
- In conjunction with any other special promotion, unless specifically advertised
- On any special excursion train
- On bus services, except for PlusBus tickets to/from towns and cities in Devon and Cornwall where PlusBus is available

Devon & Cornwall Gold Card

Customers purchasing an annual season ticket for a journey wholly within Devon and Cornwall from 10 September, are eligible for a Devon & Cornwall Gold Card, giving the same benefits as a Devon & Cornwall Railcard, at no additional cost.
