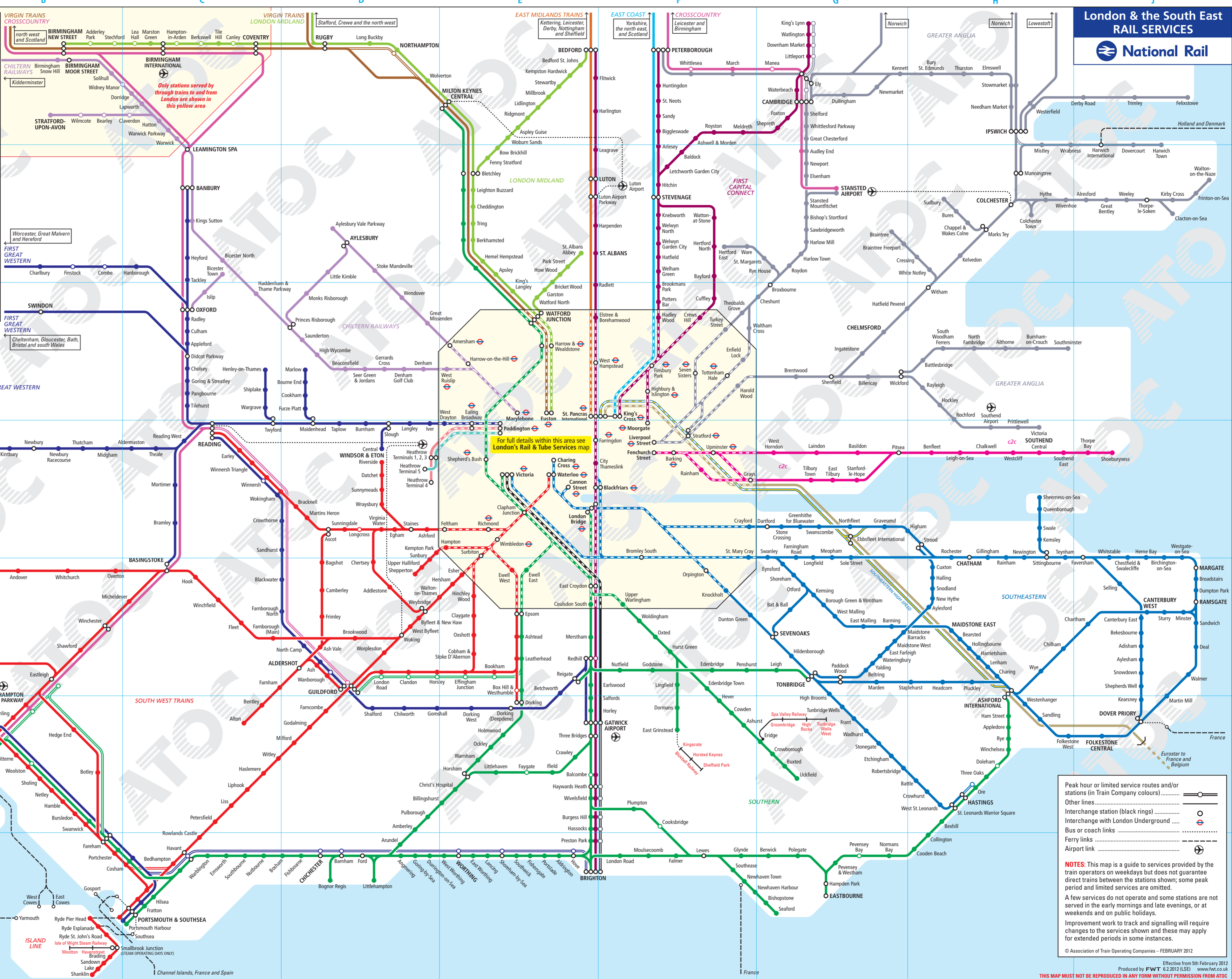


FIND YOUR STATION: A grid of station names and their corresponding alphanumeric codes for quick reference.
