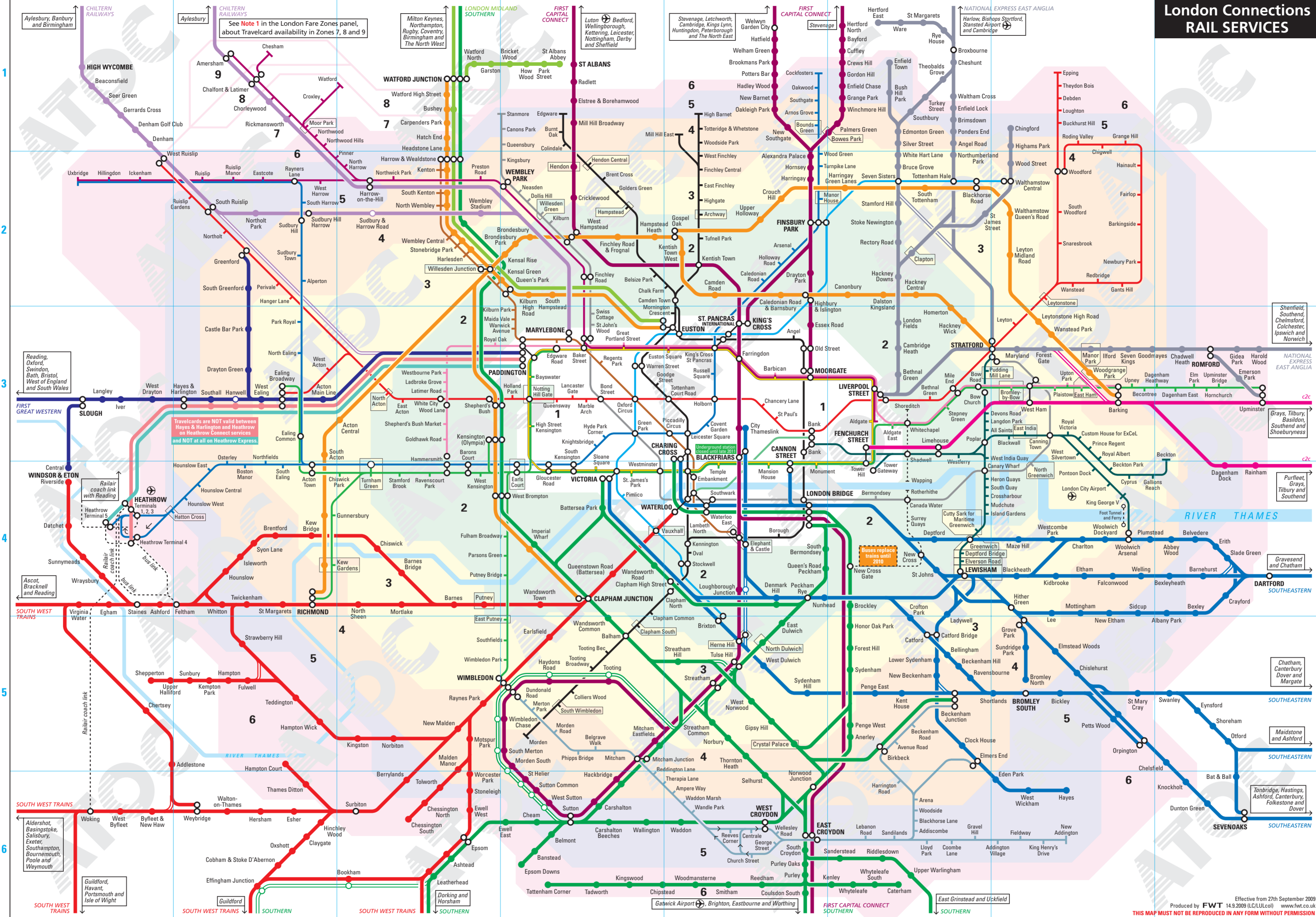

Day single or return tickets: Ticket prices for journeys between any two stations within the London Fare Zones area are determined by the zones travelled in and through. Different prices apply for journeys that are wholly between stations on Underground and/or Docklands Light Railway (DLR) services.

Travelcards: Travelcards are available in selected combinations of Fare Zones and provide unlimited travel on National Rail, Underground and DLR services within the Zones and on the day(s) for which the ticket is valid.

Notes: This map is a guide to services provided by the train operators on weekdays but does not guarantee direct trains between the stations shown; some peak period services are omitted.
A few services do not operate and some stations are not served in the early mornings and late evenings, or at weekends and on public holidays.
