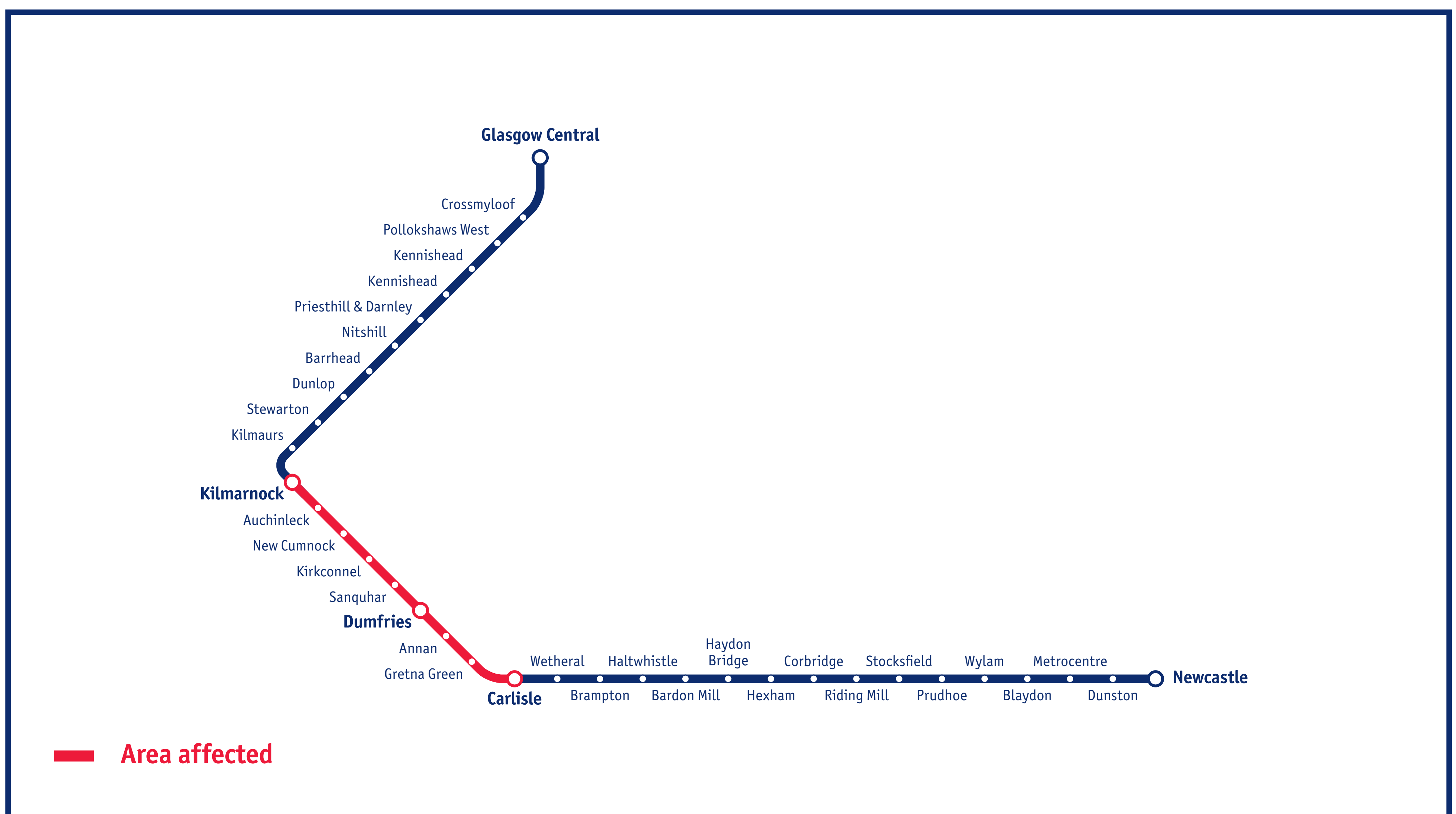


# Service Alterations

## Glasgow – Carlisle / Newcastle

**Saturday 17 July**  
**Monday 19 to Friday 23 July**



Replacement bus provision is limited and customers may be required to queue or travel on the next bus.

If you travel to / from any of the stations marked in red above, buses will replace trains for all or part of your journey.
