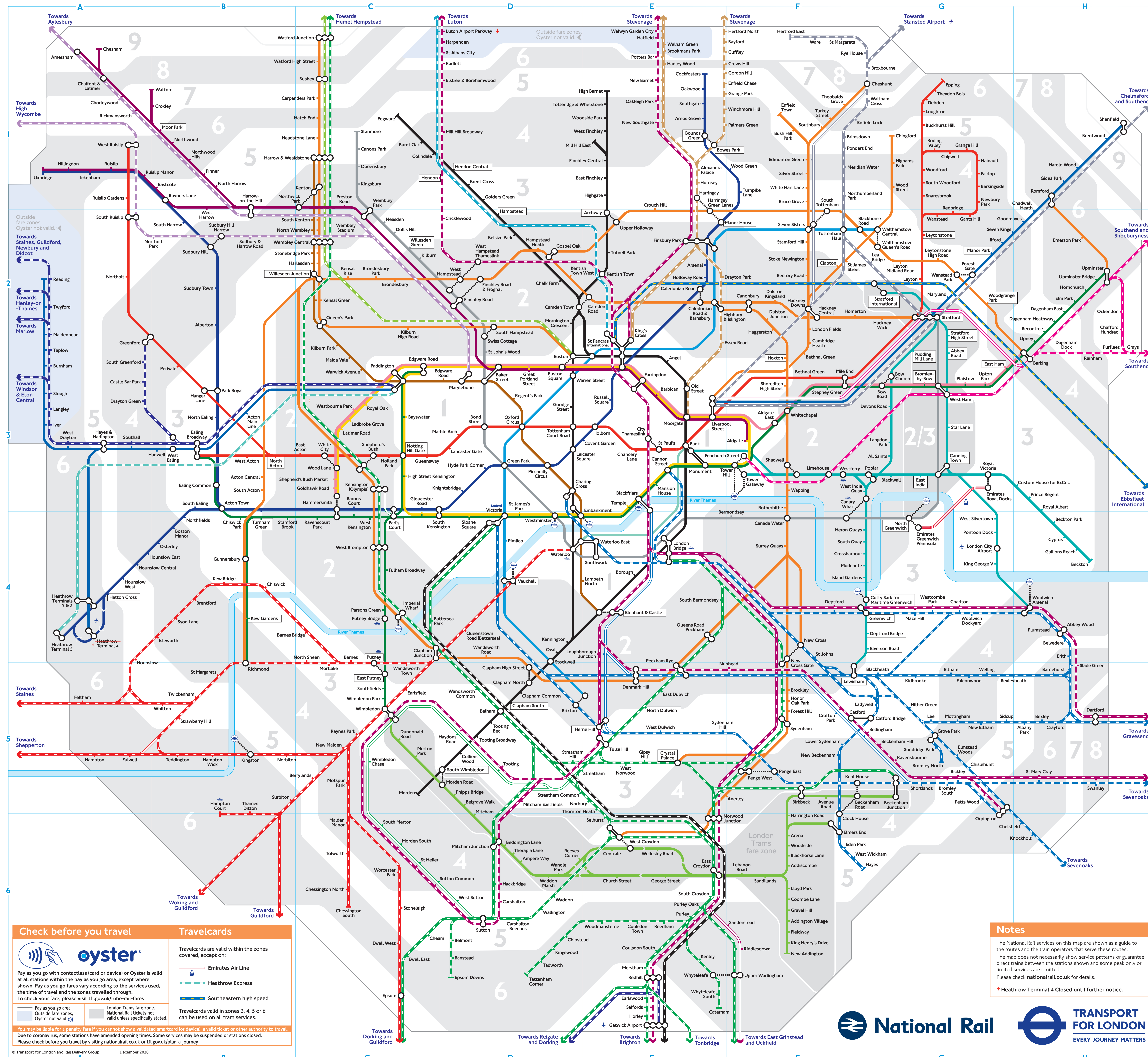

Pay as you go with contactless (card or device) or Oyster is valid at all stations within the pay as you go area, except where shown. Pay as you go fares vary according to the services used, the time of travel and the zones travelled through.

Travelcards

Travelcards are valid within the zones covered, except on:

- Emirates Air Line
- Heathrow Express
- Southeastern high speed

Travelcards valid in zones 3, 4, 5 or 6 can be used on all tram services.

You may be liable for a penalty fare if you cannot show a validated smartcard (or device), a valid ticket or other authority to travel. Due to coronavirus, some stations have amended opening times.
