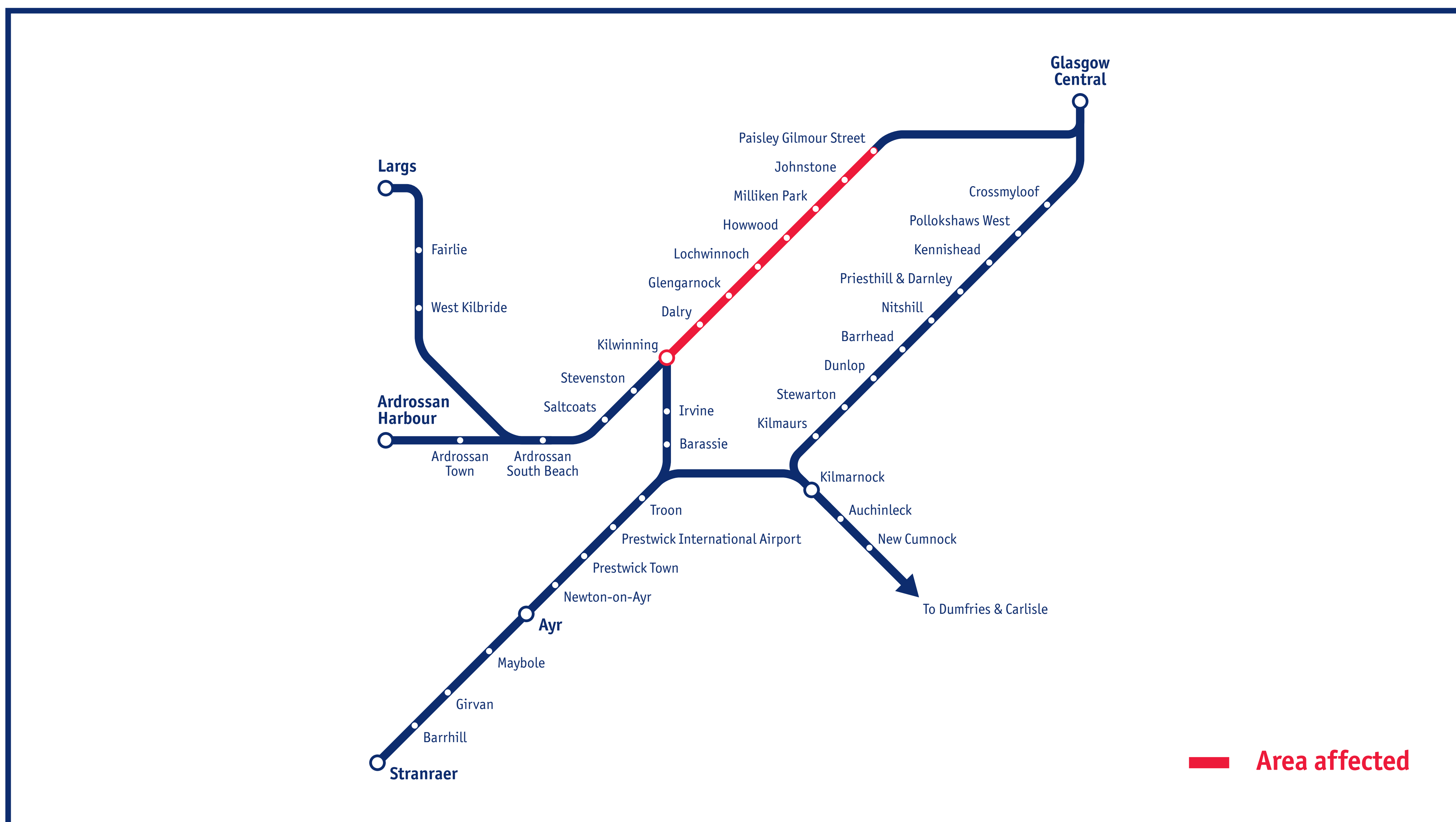


Service Alterations

Replacement bus provision is limited and customers may be required to queue or travel on the next bus.

If you travel to / from any of the stations marked in red above, buses will replace trains for all or part of your journey.

Buses replace trains between Paisley Gilmour Street and Kilwinning.

A direct bus will also operate between Glasgow Central and Ardrossan Harbour to connect with ferry sailings.
