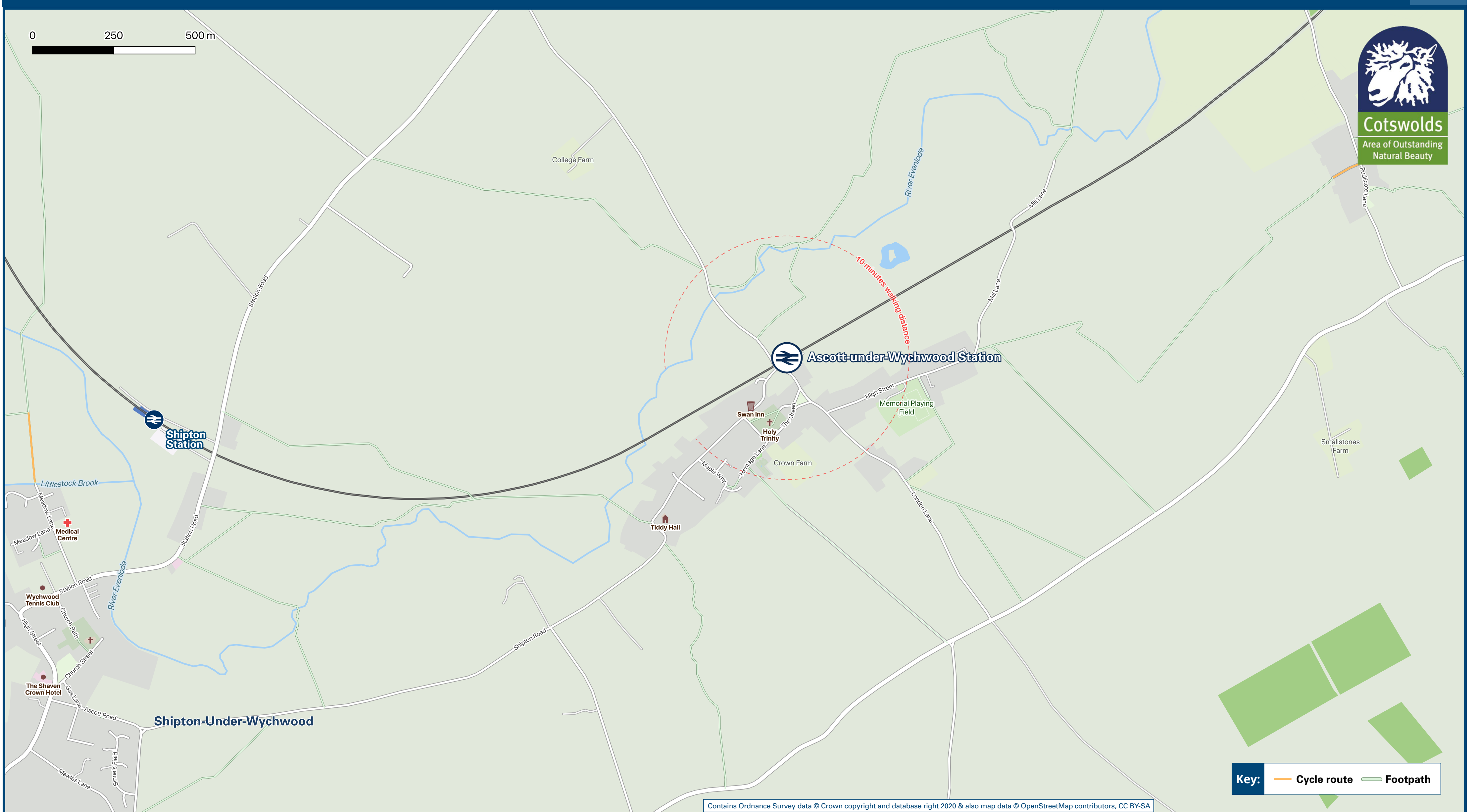




# Ascott-under-Wychwood Station
