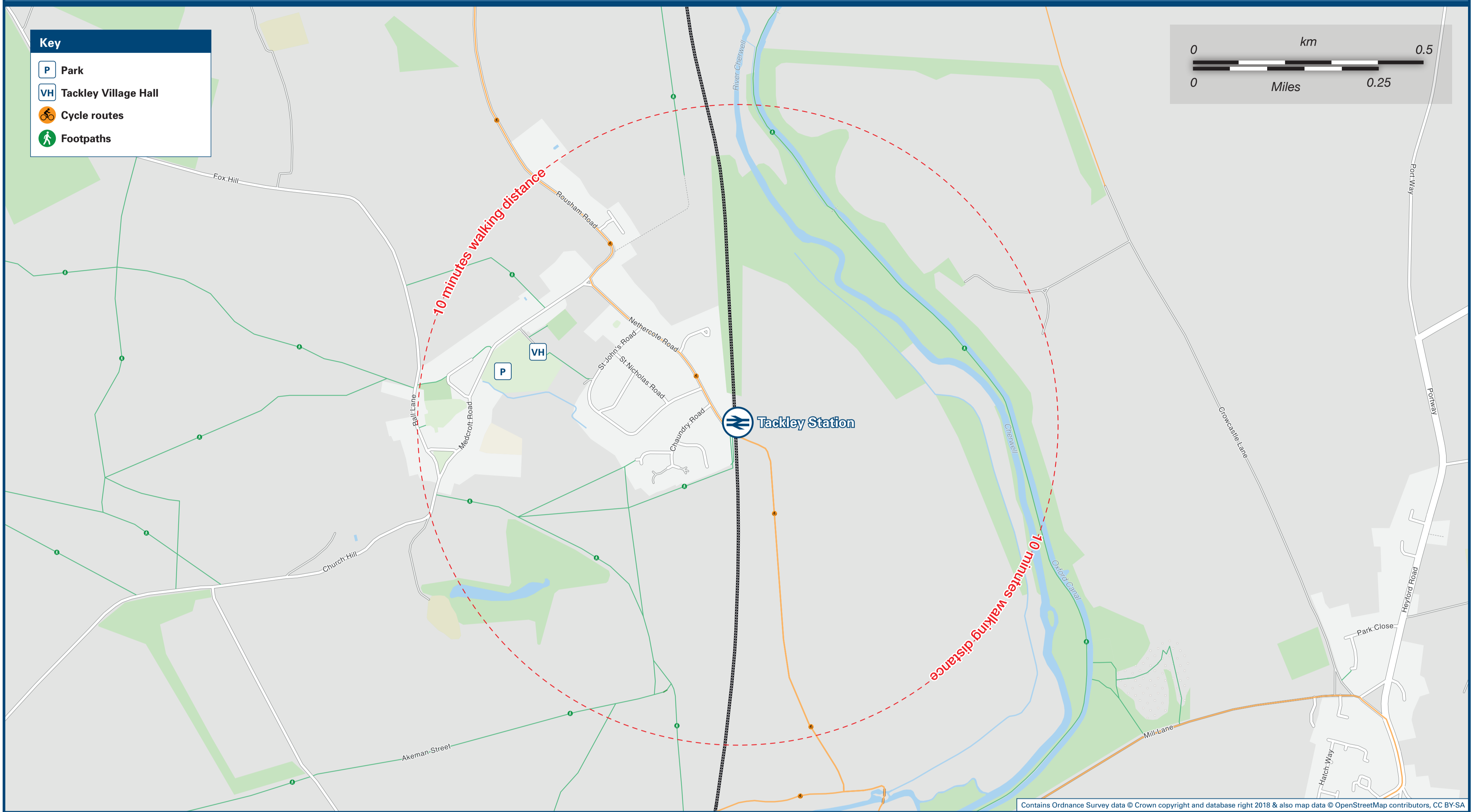




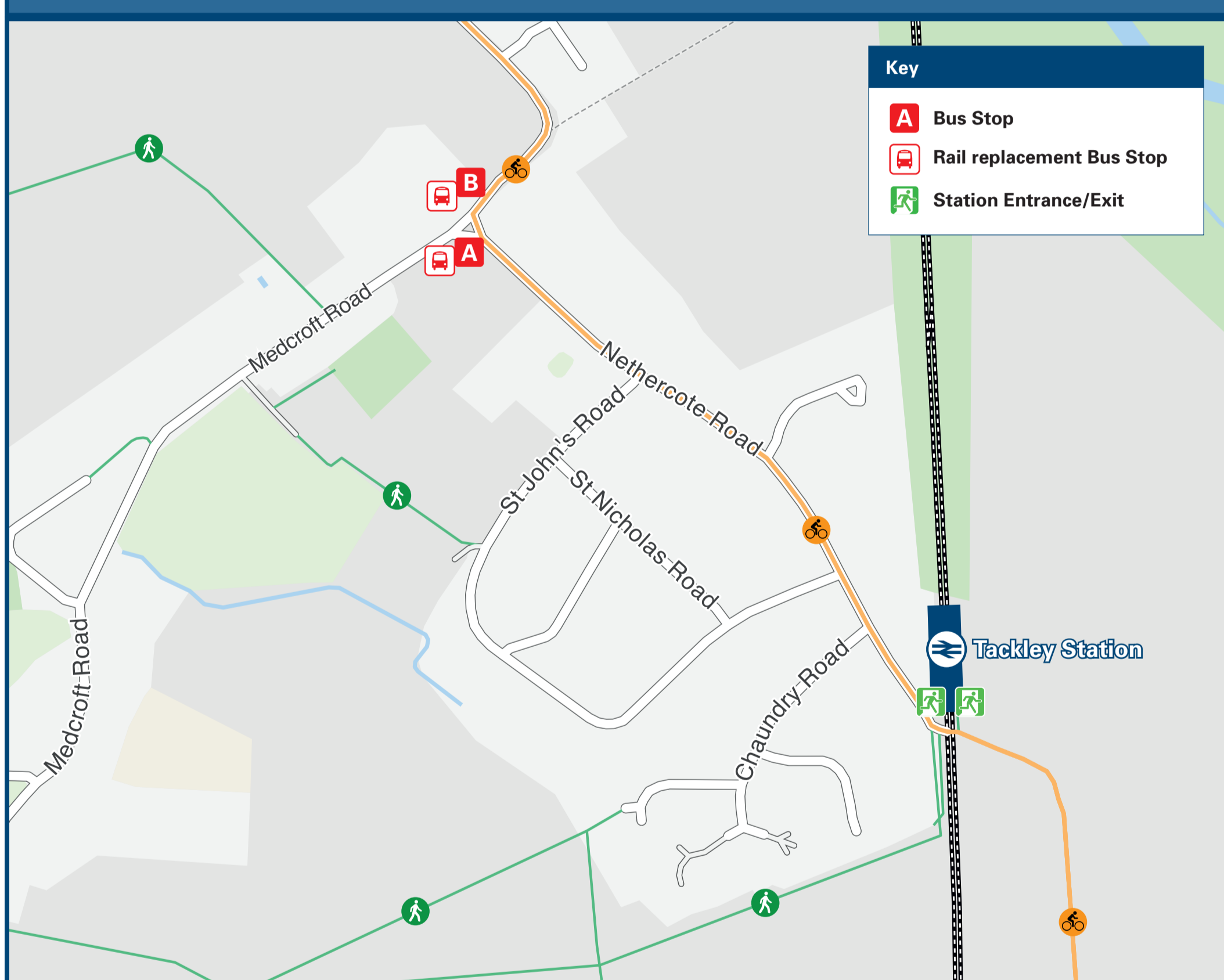
# Tackley Station

Rail replacement buses/coaches depart from the grass triangle at the junction of Nethercote Road and Medcroft Road (near to bus stops A & B on the map above). This is approximately 200 yards from the station.
